Jeremiah 17:9 *The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?*

Out of all the goals we should set this year, WHAT SHOULD BE OUR MAIN GOAL?

IT SHOULD BE TO BE MORE LIKE CHRIST!

1 Peter 1:15-16 *But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; 16 because it is written, be ye holy; for I am holy.*

b. We must acknowledge the _____ of God

2. There must be _____.

a. Acknowledgement does no _____ unless there is confessing.

Proverbs 28:13 *He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy.*

Deuteronomy 4:29 *But if from thence thou shalt seek the LORD thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul.*

Jeremiah 29:13 *And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart.*
