#### REVIEW

*Pro. 1:7 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.*

*Pro. 4:7 Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding.*

- 1. A wise person is deeply aware of the fact that they are accountable to God for all they say, do, and think.**

*Pro 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.*

- 2. The wise person has the ability to get along with people.**

*Pro 11:12 He that is void of wisdom despiseth his neighbour: but a man of understanding holdeth his peace.*

*Pro 12:8 A man shall be commended according to his wisdom: but he that is of a perverse heart shall be despised.*

**3. The wise person desires wisdom enough to avoid anything and anyone that will keep them from it.**

*Pro 18:1 Through desire a man, having separated himself, seeketh and intermeddleth with all wisdom.*

**4. The wise person has a sincere love and appreciation for those who care enough to reprove them.**

*Pro 17:10 A reproof entereth more into a wise man than an hundred stripes into a fool.*

**5. The wise person is a blessing to their parents.**

*Pro 10:1 The proverbs of Solomon. A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son is the heaviness of his mother.*

**6. The wise person doesn't live for the "now" they plan, and look ahead.**

*Pro 10:5 He that gathereth in summer is a wise son: but he that sleepeth in harvest is a son that causeth shame.*

**7. The wise person is willing to submit to their authorities.**

*Pro 24:21 My son, fear thou the Lord and the king: and meddle not with them that are given to change.*

**8. The wise person is a life long learner, he never "arrives".**

*Pro 1:5 A wise man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels:*

## **9. The wise person has the ability to control their words.**

*Pro 10:19 In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin: but he that refraineth his lips is wise.*

## **10. The wise person will win others to Christ.**

*Pro 11:30 The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise.*

*2 Tim. 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart*

*Gen 39:10-12 And it came to pass, as she spake to Joseph day by day, that he hearkened not unto her, to lie by her, or to be with her. And it came to pass about this time, that Joseph went into the house to do his business; and there was none of the men of the house there within. And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.*
