There are several reasons why we as parents, should take the time to study Biblical childrearing:

- Because whether we know what the Biblical perspective for childrearing is or not, our children will learn from us (good or bad) one way or the other
- Because children can be a source of great discouragement and displacement if they are not raised in the nurture and admonition of the Lord
- Because an untrained, neglected child can cause great stress to a family
- Because untrained children can cause us to do less than we did before for the Lord
