## =MAJOR CHARACTERS OF THE BIBLE=

Lesson 11 Stephen

<u>POINT OF CONTACT</u>: See how many of the deacons of our church the class can name.

- I. <u>THE WORD STEPHEN MEANS A "WREATH" OR A "CROWN</u>." This means that he won a martyr's crown.
- II. HE WAS, NO DOUBT, THE LEADER OF THE DEACONS. See Acts 6:5.
- III. <u>BEING A DEACON, OF COURSE, HE MET THE QUALIFICATIONS SET DOWN IN THE BIBLE</u> FOR DEACONS.
  - 1. He was a serious-minded man. Notice I Timothy 3:8.
  - 2. He was not a gossip, nor was he critical. I Timothy 3:8, "...not doubletongued...."
  - 3. He was a temperate person. I Timothy 3:8, "...not given to much wine...."
  - 4. He was aboveboard in financial matters. I Timothy 3:8, "...not greedy of filthy lucre."
  - 5. <u>He was experienced in the Lord's work</u>. See I Timothy 3:10.
  - 6. He was a man of character. Study Acts 6:3a.
  - 7. He was full of the Holy Spirit. Review Acts 6:3b.
  - 8. He was a wise man. Consider Acts 6:3c.
  - 9. He was full of faith. Read Acts 6:5.
  - 10. He was full of power. See Acts 6:8.
  - 11. <u>He was the husband of one wife</u>. Notice I Timothy 3:12a.
  - 12. He was the head of his house and ruled his children and household well.
- IV. SINCE HE WAS A CHOSEN DEACON, HIS WIFE ALSO WAS A CERTAIN KIND OF LADY, BEING A RESPECTABLE PERSON, NOT CRITICAL; SHE WAS SOBER AND FAITHFUL. See I Timothy 3:11.
- V. <u>STEPHEN, NO DOUBT, WAS A GREEK BY BIRTH</u>. "Stephen" itself is a Greek name. He was the first one appointed to settle the complaints made by the Grecian widows.
- VI. <u>HE WAS A PREACHING DEACON</u>. Study Acts 7:2-53.
- VII. <u>HE WAS THE FIRST CHRISTIAN MARTYR</u>. Read Acts 7:60.
- VIII. <u>HE WAS WELCOMED BY JESUS INTO HEAVEN</u>. Notice Acts 7:55, 56.
- IX. <u>HE HAD MUCH TO DO WITH PAUL'S CONVERSION</u>. See Acts 7:58.
- X. <u>HIS DEATH WAS THE CAUSE OF THE SPREADING OF THE GOSPEL FROM JERUSALEM.</u> Review Acts 8:1, 4.
- XI. HE WAS THE CAUSE OF THE FOUNDING OF THE CHURCH AT ANTIOCH. Consider Acts 11:19.
